Academic Session : 2022-23

Historical Background and Current Status:

The foundation stone of Govt. College of Education, Patiala was laid down by the Chief Minister of PEPSU Government Shri Brish Bhan on July 16th, 1955 and the building was inaugurated by Home Minister of the Government of India Shri G.B. Pant on September 28th, 1956. The college has a vast campus spread over 41.74 acres. Initially the institute started with B.Ed, M.Ed, J.B.T, and O.T classes but with the progression of time and the school directorate parting ways J.B.T and O.T classes were discontinued and a portion of the college building was used for the establishment of Govt. Bikram College of Commerce. The portion where the Govt. In-Service Teacher's training centre was being run is currently being used by Jagat Guru Nanak Dev Open University as transit campus.

Govt. College of Education, Patiala is a premier institute of teacher training in Northern India. The College has in its campus an auditorium with a seating capacity of 500, an upper lecture theatre with a seating capacity of 200-250. Moving with the technological advances the college has 10 smart class rooms, a virtual classroom, computer centre with internet facility and language lab. The institute boasts of a rich library with 40,000books. It also has a child care centre, playground, hostel facility for boys & girls, fitness centre, art room, music room and various facilities. The institute has the proud privilege of having produced scores of teachers who have contributed to the education sector in keeping with the vision & mission of the college in the post independent era. Students for all over the nation feel proud to seek admission in this college. Students who have passed out through this institute are serving the society in various government & non-government education institutes.

Working on the motto of the college 'Nishkam Sewa' (selfless service) the college organises various academic, literary, sports, cultural and co-curricular activities for the all-round development of the students.

Admission and Results:

In the session 2022-23 there are 150 students (117 Girls & 33 Boys) in B.Ed.-I, 95 students (84 Girls & 11 Boys) in B.Ed.-II, 16 students (13 Girls & 03 Boys) in M.Ed.-I & in M.Ed-II there are 08 students (05 Girls & 03 Boys). All admissions are done on the

basis of merit and filled on a priority in the State of Punjab. The results for the past session was 100% of B.Ed and M.Ed classes.

In the session 2022-23 , 54 students of our college cleared CTET, and two have cleared NET.

The college library is a reservoir of knowledge. It houses more than 41,000 books, 660 dissertations, 100 encyclopaedia's, various dictionaries, atlases, educational reports, books pertaining to various competitive exams, 25 journals /magazines and 8 newspapers which are at the disposal for the perusal of students and staff.

From the last session a provision has been provided to members of society, who can also now access the library resources. Enriching its resources further around 200 new books were purchased. The library has a seating capacity of 70 students and catering to the needs of the students book bank facility is available.

To develop reading habits among the students a number of book exhibitions were organised from time to time. There are 10 computer systems available at the library to access the e-library e-catalogue services. The college library provides internship (practical training) to B.Lib and M.Lib pass out students whose number is 65 till date.



Other Activities:


